The BBC Television Centre - designed by Graham Dawbarn and built in 1960 - was the BBC's first purpose built centre for television production. It's situated four miles from central London at Shepherd's Bush (also the location of BBC White City and BBC Worldwide), on a site used for the famous Franco-British Exhibition of 1908.

All features of the building are designed with television production in mind. A distinctive circular main block houses technical areas and equipment together with facilities for artists and administration. Grouped around are studios linked by a covered walkway to a scenery block, allowing swift movement of scenery and props.

Amazon undertook the replacement of over 500 casement windows to various buildings including the television centre, and numerous secondary glazing projects with specialist acoustic sound proofing to the recording studios.



There were several major considerations whilst draughting the proposal for this fitment:

- 1 The products had to follow a strict colour scheme and sliding design that was safe to use.
- 2 The first floor suffers from extremes of thermal gain during the summers creating discomfort for the students and staff.
- 3 The height of the rooms meant that the top windows were unreachable.

The solution was to produce and install a major curtain walling whereby all external walls were made up of interlinking windows and thermal panels with an integrated operating system to access all windows. This unique walling provided functionality and thermal protection in a robust yet flexible installation.



This modern highly glazed building is set on the main Frimley Green Road near Camberley.

Amazon has replaced a majority of the windows, doors and vertical walling products in a mix of silver anodised and white polyester powder coated aluminium incorporating Pilkington anti-sun solar control float glass as the building suffers from high solar gain during the warmer months of the year.
